Main cases

Both the criminal misc. shall dispose of by a common order as both the petitioners are accused in same FIR.

The present petition is filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of regular bail in FIR No.51 dated 22.2.2020 registered under Section 22 of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

While praying for bail, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are registered medical practitioners. Licence is placed on record. It is an admitted case that only evidence against the petitioners is the statement of the co-accused. No recovery has been effected from them till date.

Admittedly, no other case is pending against the petitioners as per the custody certificates.

In view of the above, the present petitions are allowed and the petitioners are released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
