Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of the appropriate writ or direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members at the hands of the private respondents.

As per the assertions made in the petition, respondent No. 6- Ajmer Singh, Sarpanch of the village, has caused atrocities upon the petitioners and their family members in connivance with the police. The brother of the petitioner No. 2 was the tenant of respondent No. 6 and had taken shops on rent and respondent No. 6 made an attempt to oust him from the said shop and accordingly the proceedings of civil and criminal nature are pending between them. The petitioners are husband and wife and they are

being harassed and humiliated by respondent No. 6. The house of the petitioners was attacked by respondents No. 6 and 7 in connivance with each other in midnight.

Learned State counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that as per the reply of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Bholath, District Kapurthala, filed by way of affidavit dated 09.06.2020, seven FIRs have been registered against the petitioner No. 2 and his son. When the raids were conducted to arrest them, the present petition has been filed just to create a false story to protect him.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to allow the prayer made in the present petition.

Dismissed.
