Present criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents who are bent upon to kill her because she does not want to live with respondent No.4.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to the remedy available to her before the Court of competent jurisdiction.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforementioned.
