The petitioner has filed the present criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of habeas corpus.

The petitioner claimed that the persons detailed in para 3 of the petition are being illegally detained by the owner of Brick-Kiln. The petitioner is alleged to have sent a representation on 27.05.2020 i.e. Yesterday.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, Fazilka who is an appropriate authority under the Bonded Labour System (Abolition) Act, 1976 to consider and decide the representation within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
