GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.127, dated 15.8.2018, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur, under Sections 450, 326, 324, 323, 506, 341, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 10.5.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Sangrur, has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioners/accused Labh Singh, Billu Singh, Harnek Singh, Kamaljit Kaur and also of complainant Ranjit Kaur @ Rani, her husband

Gurjant Singh and injured-Jaswinder Kaur have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant and injured in their statement has specifically stated that they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Sangrur, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and the compromise is genuine one.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.127, dated 15.8.2018, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur, under Sections 450, 326, 324, 323, 506, 341, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
