On 01.06.2020, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“The matter has been taken up by way of Video Conferencing through Webex Application facility in view of Covid-19 situation as per instructions issued.

Inter-alia contends that the attribution towards the petitioner is of an attack of sword upon Gurmit Singh which injured the small finger of his left hand. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that it is a case of version and cross version since the petitioner has also suffered injuries as reproduced in paragraph no.3 of the petition which is also grievous.

Notice of motion for 6.8.2020.

Mr. Gaurav Dhuriwala, Senior Deputy

Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that injury no.1 has been declared as grievous.

However, counsels are not in a position as such to show the extent of injury inflicted upon Gurmit Singh in the form of Medico Legal Report.

In the meantime, it is directed that the petitioner shall join investigation and in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on ad-interim bail by the investigating officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when required and shall comply with the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baljeet Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the order dated 01.06.2020 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
