Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in compliance with the order passed by this Court on 02.06.2020, petitioner has joined investigation and got recovered the alleged weapon. This fact is admitted by the counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Baljit Singh, Police Station Ghanaur, District Patiala.

Counsel for the complainant, however, vehemently opposes the prayer made by the counsel for the petitioner.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner had only fired in the air and no injury has been attributed to him and the weapon also stands recovered, the present petition is allowed.

Order dated 02.06.2020 is hereby confirmed.

Petitioner shall, however, continue to abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) (i) to (iv) Cr.P.C.
