MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner for directing the respondents to finalize the disciplinary proceedings initiated against the petitioner vide chargesheet dated 10.08.2017 (P-1) as well as for quashing the chargesheet dated 17.10.2018 (P-5).

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he would be satisfied in case the competent authority is directed to conclude the disciplinary proceedings on some early date. Prayer seems to be justified and accepted.

In view of the above, without going into the merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to direct respondent No.1 to conclude the disciplinary proceedings against the petitioner on the basis of chargesheet dated 10.08.2017 (P-1) and 17.10.2018 (P-5) expeditiously, but not later than 31.10.2020.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed off.

Needless to say that in case no adverse decision is taken finally against the petitioner by the competent authority and he is found entitled, then his retiral dues be released forthwith.
