All the cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

By these two petitions, the two petitioners challenge their transfer order. Though no reply has been filed to either petition, as regards the petitioner in CWP no.7552 of 2020, i.e. Dr. Anuradha, learned State counsel submits that the impugned transfer order has already been cancelled, which is not refuted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

That being so, CWP no.7552 of 2020 is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

As regards the petitioner in CWP no.7370 of 2020, i.e. Dr. R.D. Wadhawan, learned State counsel on instructions from Dr. Kewal Kumar,

submits that his case is under consideration and the final decision would be taken within two or three days.

CWP no.7370 of 2020 is adjourned to 21.08.2020.

If his transfer is not cancelled, then the written statement would be filed positively well before that date, giving therein the reasons as to how the impugned order is sustainable.
