Prayer made in the present Criminal Misc. is for granting anticipatory bail in the event of arrest in FIR No.170 dated 11.5.2020 registered under Sections 147,149,323,452,506 of IPC at Police Station, Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

Vide order dated 1.6.2020, this Court while granting interim anticipatory bail passed the following relevant order:-

“CRM M-13348 of 2020

Inter alia submits that the dispute pertains to a loan taken by the complainant from petitioner No.2-Deepak. The allegations are that the petitioners climbed the back wall and had beaten the complainant and his wife, when their sons were not present at 11:45 PM and the injuries are only simple on the lady and it is highly unlikely since the petitioners are stated to be armed with *Lathis, Dandas and Gandasi*.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Chetan Sharma, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent/State.

List on 07.08.2020.

In the meantime, it is directed that the petitioners shall join investigation and in the event of arrest of the petitioners, they shall be released on ad-interim bail by the investigating officer. The petitioners shall join investigation as and when required and shall comply with the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Counsel for the State on instructions from HC Ravinder Kumar submits that the petitioners have joined investigation and they are no longer required for further investigation at this stage.

Keeping in view of above, interim dated 1.6.2020 is ordered to be confirmed.

The Criminal Misc. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
