The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the event of arrest in FIR No. 64 dated 21.04.2020 under Sections 452, 323, 379-B, 427, 148, 149 Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioners No. 2 to 4 are falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, have joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned DAG Punjab for the respondent-State, on instructions

from ASI Darshan Singh, submits that petitioners No. 2 to 4 have joined the investigation and they are not required for the custodial interrogation. In fact, a cancellation report is in the process of being prepared.

Per contra, learned counsel for the complainant opposes the grant of bail to the petitioners No. 2 to 4 while submitting that the offences levelled against them are serious in nature.

However, in view of the facts that petitioners No. 2 to 4 are no longer required for custodial interrogation and have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 10.07.2020 granting interim bail to petitioners No. 2 to 4 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
