The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 116 dated 23.12.2019 registered at Police Station Rori, District Sirsa, under Section 22B of the NDPS Act, 1985.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for over 07 months and the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as no PW has been examined till date. The recovery has been planted on the petitioner as is evident from the FIR and thus, he deserves to be granted regular bail.

3. Custody certificate dated 27.07.2020 has been filed in Court. The same is taken on record. According to this certificate, the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 07 months and 04 days and there is no criminal case pending/decided against the petitioner.

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4. Learned State counsel admits that no PW has been examined till date.

5. Keeping in view the custody period as well as the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail.

6. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
