The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Prayer in this petition is for anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 7 dated 31.01.2020 registered under Sections 307, 341, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Fattu DHINGA, District Kapurthala.

Allegations are that the petitioner along with Shankar Singh son of Dharam Singh were consuming liquor and they started abusing husband of the complainant. When husband of the complainant reached a little ahead of the market towards village Fazlabad, then Shankar Singh and the petitioner came on their motorcycle and by encircling the injured started giving beatings to

him. Petitioner and said Shankar Singh hit the injured with their Karhas (iron bangles) on his head. Injured Narinder Singh has a large cut on his forehead, covering his right eye. There is a loss of vision of the said eye.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in respect of one injury, two accused cannot be implicated. Injured has improved his version vis-a-vis receipt of injuries at the hands of the petitioner.

After the first part of the occurrence, co-accused also joined the petitioner and said Shankar Singh, resulting in more injuries on the persons of the complainant party.

Keeping in view the nature of injury inflicted on the person of injured- Narinder Singh, I do not see any ground to grant indulgence for grant of anticipatory bail in favour of the petitioner.

This petition is accordingly, dismissed.
