The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.125 dated 27.08.2019, under Sections 342, 384, 385, 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short) and Sections 25/27/54 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that she along with co-accused had blackmailed the complainant. The petitioner is 40 years old lady and is suffering from various ailments including hypertension and bronchitis. He also contends that she is treated at Civil Hospital, Dhuri and prescription in this regard is annexed at Annexure P-3.

This Court, by the order dated 10.06.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail

to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 10.06.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
