The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.0058 dated 28.07.2019, under Sections 15 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Behram, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar (Annexure P-1).

[2]. The petitioner was apprehended on 05.03.2020, when he was allegedly trying to leave the country. The available material on record, however, does not disclose anything tangible against the petitioner. He has basically been implicated on account of the disclosure statement made against him by co-accused Harbhajan Singh. Contraband weighing 35 kgs. of poppy-husk was allegedly recovered from an abandoned car and consequently another 115 kgs. of poppy-husk was recovered from the haweli/house of the same Harbhajan Singh.

[3]. It is not clear how further detention of the present petitioner in the present case at this stage is called for.

[4]. In view of above, the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned, subject to the condition that he shall not leave the country without permission.
