The present writ petitions have been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India in the nature of certiorari for quashing of impugned order dated 09.05.2018 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.4-Deputy Registrar.

Admittedly, the order of removal from the Managing Committee has been passed under Section 27 of the Punjab Co-operative

Societies Act, 1961 (for short 'the Act') on 23.05.2019. As per Section 68(1) (e) of the Act, the said appeal is provided under (2) (b) against the order of the Deputy Registrar to the Registrar or such Additional Registrar or Joint Registrar as may be authorised by the Registrar in this behalf.

Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be relegated to have remedy to file the appeal before the appellate authority. He further prays that his balance tenure is only for a period of another 7 months and thus requested that the appellate authority be asked to decide the appeals expeditiously.

Keeping in view the above, the present writ petitions are disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to approach the appellate authority within a period of one week from today. In case, the appeals are filed, appellate authority shall take steps to decide the appeals within a period of two months from the date of filing of the appeals.

Accordingly, applications for amendment and impleadment of the writ petitions are dismissed as not pressed.
