All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this petition, with liberty to file a fresh one after placing on record documents pertaining to the alleged mode of recovery of contraband from the petitioner, with the FIR simply stating that information was received from a secret informer.

Learned counsel for the State submits that as a matter of fact there are a number of criminal cases registered against the petitioner.

Without making any comment on the contention raised, this petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action, annexing therewith whatever documents that the petitioner wishes to place on record, but with it made absolutely clear that, naturally, the said petition would be heard wholly on its own merits, with no observation made hereinabove to be treated to be a comment on the merits of the case by this court.
