This petition has been filed by wife seeking transfer of a petition filed by her husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, titled as "Ajay Kumar Bhankher v. Manju" from the Court of District Judge, Family Court, Bhiwani to any other Court of competent jurisdiction at district Sirsa.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that applicant is residing at her parental house at Sirsa. She has one minor daughter to look after. She has no source of income. It is very difficult for her to travel from Sirsa to Bhiwani on each and every date of hearing.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the records of the case.

4. Learned counsel for the applicant also relies upon judgment of Hon'ble Apex Court in case titled **Sumita Singh Vs.**

Kumar Sanjay and another, AIR 2002 SC 396, wherein it is held that transfer of matrimonial proceedings initiated by the husband

against wife, convenience of the wife ought to be looked into.

5. In the premise, present application is allowed. The petition in question pending before the Court of District Judge, Family Court, Bhiwani is ordered to be withdrawn from that Court and is transferred to District Judge, Sirsa, for its disposal in accordance with law by the Court concerned.
