The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Vide this common order, CRM-M No. 13442 of 2020 titled 'Rajwinder Kaur vs State of Punjab' and CRM-M No. 14405 of 2020 titled 'Karamjit Singh vs State of Punjab' are being disposed of.

At the time of issuance of notice of motion, factual position of the case was appreciated in the context of inter-se relationship between the parties.

Rajwinder Kaur is sister-in-law (devrani) of the complainant. Karamjit Singh is her husband.

The FIR came to be registered on 05.05.2020 in respect of an occurrence dated 03.05.2020. Husband of the complainant has given an affidavit dated 20.05.2020 to the effect that no such occurrence has taken place.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) contends that in pursuance of interim order passed by this Court in both the petitions, petitioner(s) therein have joined the investigation and are no more required in further investigation of the case.

This position has been admitted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Prem Chand.

In view of above, interim orders dated 01.06.2020 and 09.06.2020 passed in CRM-M No.13442 of 2020 and CRM-M No.14405 of 2020 respectively are hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner(s) shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so by the Investigating Officer.
