Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 633 dated 02.12.2019 registered under Sections 120-B, 406 and 420 IPC at Police Station Ambala Cantt, District Ambala.

In the present case, the petitioner along with co-accused Saroj Narang, had assured the complainant that their amount will be doubled, if they invested money in Truck Money Transport Solutions. The complainant was invited and on their assurance she had invested a total amount of Rs. 21 lakh, out of which she has received back only Rs. 5,73,486/-, and moreover, the cheques issued in favour of the complainant had been dishonoured.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 08.01.2020.

In view of the above, I do not find any ground to grant him the concession of regular bail.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
