The petitioners are seeking direction to restrain the official respondents from harassing them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the relatives of the petitioners namely Gursant Singh who is allegedly involved in a criminal case and on some pretext or the other, the official respondents have been detaining the petitioners and harassing them. Petitioners are the relatives of one Sukhleen Kaur, who had love marriage with Gursant Singh.

Learned State counsel has filed affidavit of Sarbjit Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, North, Amritsar City wherein it has stated that the police had earlier visited the house of the petitioners to know whereabouts of Gursant Singh and they were not detained or called to the police station at any time. It is also stated that the investigation of the case has now been transferred to National Investigation Agency. Learned State counsel

also submits that as the matter stands transferred to the National Investigation Agency, the question of harassment by the officials of the Punjab Police would not arise.

In view of the reply filed by the State, no further directions are called for at this stage.

The petition stands disposed of at this stage.
