The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.161 dated 04.07.2016, under Sections 399, 402 and 201 of the IPC read with Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala.

[2]. The petitioner was initially granted bail in this case. He however, absented from the proceedings on 31.01.2017, after which coercive processes were issued against him. He was subsequently arrested in connection with some other case and thereafter produced before the Trial Court on the strength of production warrant on 19.11.2018.

[3]. Since his re-arrest, he has been facing trial while in custody for almost 1½ years now. As such, further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period is not justified.

[4]. In such circumstances, considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner at this stage, he is ordered to be released on

regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned, subject to imposition of appropriate stringent terms and conditions
