The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.73, dated 02.02.2020, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sirsa City, District Sirsa.

[2]. Perusal of the FIR goes to indicate that recovery effected from the petitioner was of commercial quantity (631 gms.) of contraband, i.e. 1,000 capsules of the drug *Tramadol Hydrochloride-Diclofenac-Sodium Dicyclomin-Hydrochloride*. It transpires that the Forensic Science Laboratory Report also confirms recovery of the aforesaid drug.

[3]. Investigation in the case has not yet been completed. As such,

this Court is not inclined to release the petitioner on bail, at this stage.
