2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.16 dated 04.02.2020, registered under Sections 498-A, 323, 312 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.
