Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case
is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The learned State counsel has made statement that
petitioner in compliance of order dated 02.06.2020 has joined the
investigation which could not be displaced by the learned State
counsel and who has rather stated that the petitioner happens to be
only a distant relative of the couple and thus, no recovery is required
to be made.

In light of the statement made by the learned State
counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated
02.06.2020 is made absolute till submission of report under Section

173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
