This Civil Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release retiral benefits including pensionary benefits, commuted pension, gratuity, leave encashment, provident fund under the revised pay scales, arrears of provident fund from 02.12.1980 to 01.10.1989 with interest at the rate of 18% per annum.

Learned counsel for petitioner contended that petitioner has already sent legal notice dated 20.02.2020 to respondents No.2 to 4, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/2, but still no action has been taken.
