The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this criminal writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner keeping in view the subsequent events and for taking action against the culprits/private respondent with a further prayer to direct the police to make endeavour to arrest the culprit.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he confined his prayer only to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Monika Jalota, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Lest it may prejudice the interest of either of the parties and without making any observations as regards the averments made in the instant petition, in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for

the petitioner to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to consider the prayer of the petitioner for a limited purpose i.e. protection to her life and liberty and to act in accordance with law.
