The petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.145 dated 30.04.2020 under Sections 188, 148, 149, 323, 308, 452, 506 IPC & Section 325 IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Sadar Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

The petitioners were granted the interim bail vide order dated 14.07.2020, which reads as under:-

“Short reply by way of affidavit of Shri Subhash Chand, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar has been filed. As per the said affidavit a lacerated wound on the parietal region of skull of Mohit Kumar has been found to be simple in nature. The grievous injury as such is injury No.2, which is on the knuckle of the right hand.

Similarly, injuries No.2 & 3 upon Man Singh are stated to be simple. Qua injury No.1 on the skull, the patient did not take the opinion from the surgeon.

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It is pointed out that the petition filed for interim anticipatory bail by co-accused Punna Ram and others bearing CRM-M-13408-2020 has been decided in their favour.

In such circumstances, the interim anticipatory bail is granted to the petitioner. It is directed that the petitioners shall join investigation and in the event of arrest of the petitioners, they shall be released on ad-interim bail by the investigating officer. The petitioners shall join investigation as and when required and shall comply with the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

List on 17.08.2020.”

Counsel for the State on instructions from HC Nirmal Singh has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, keeping in view the above, the interim bail granted to the petitioners is confirmed and the present petition is disposed off, accordingly.
