Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.102 dated 08.03.2020, registered under Sections 22 (c), 27-A/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, at Police Station City Tohana, Fatehabad.

Petitioner is facing trial in the aforesaid FIR on the allegations that on 08.03.2020, petitioner was apprehended with conscious possession of 130 strips (1300 tablets) of Alprazolam , weighing 153.400 grams and 100 strips (1000 tablets) of Tramadol Hydrochloride tablets, 100 mg, weighting 406 grams, without any permit or licence, which falls under the category of “commercial quantity”.

Learned counsel *inter alia* contends that petitioner has falsely been implicated. His wife is pregnant. His father has expired. There is no one to look after his wife.

On the other hand, learned State counsel vehemently opposed the grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Considering overall circumstances and recovery of heavy quantity of prohibited drug from the possession of petitioner without any permit or licence, this court is not inclined to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
