The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail in FIR No.0052 dated 08.02.2020, registered under Sections 323, 506 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

Seeking regular bail for the petitioner learned counsel submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case; is a young man aged 21 years and has no criminal background; he has been behind bars since 05.03.2020; challan under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been filed and he is therefore, no longer required by the investigating agency;

completion of trial is likely to take a long time and that the complainant and injured have no objection to the grant of bail to the petitioner.

The above factual position is not disputed by the learned State counsel.

Learned counsel for the complainant and the injured has appeared and stated that his clients have no objection if the petitioner is granted bail.

For the reason that the petitioner is a young man aged 21 years; has no criminal background; he is admittedly no longer required by the investigating agency and the trial is likely to take a long time this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose would be served in further incarceration of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present case is considered to be a fit one in which the petitioner be directed to be released on regular bail. Resultantly, subject to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Fatehabad, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail.

It is clarified that the above observations have been made only for the limited purpose of deciding the present regular bail application and the same would not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
