Learned counsels appearing on behalf of the respective parties submit that the parties have orally settled their dispute and according to the oral settlement, the claimant will be paid a sum of ₹1,65,000/- (₹ One Lac Sixty Five Thousand Only) over and above the amount of ₹25,000/- already awarded by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Chandigarh. Learned counsels appearing on behalf of the Insurance Company submit that the amount of ₹1,65,000/- will be paid to the claimant within a period of three weeks from today.

As the parties have already settled their dispute in an oral agreement, the same may be implemented and the present appeal is disposed of with the direction that keeping in view the oral settlement between the parties, another sum of ₹1,65,000/- i.e. over and above the sum of ₹25,000/-

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already awarded by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Chandigarh, be released in favour of the claimant within a period of three weeks from today. As undertaken by learned counsels appearing on behalf of the Insurance Company, amount be released through RTGS.

The claimant is directed to supply his bank details to the Insurance Company within a period of one week from today so that the awarded amount can be deposited in his bank account within the time fixed hereinbefore.
