The present application is for exemption from filing the Court Fee in support of the main Petition.

The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail in case FIR No.23, dated 15.02.2020, registered under Sections 307/326/325/323/341/506/336/148/

149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Nehianwala, District Bathinda.

2. Submits *inter alia* that the FIR discloses that the Petitioner was only armed with a Baseball Bat and that all the actual assaults on the Victim-Complainant are imputed to co-accused Sukhdev Singh.

3. The Petitioner has by now remained in detention for 04 months since 17th February, 2020.

4. Challan against him has already been submitted after completion of investigation.

5. In the circumstances, further detention of the present Petitioner for an indefinite period is not justified. As such, he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
