ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral):

Petitioners pray for mandamus commanding the official respondents (respondents No.1 to 3) to protect their lives and liberty.

Petitioners Mamta and Mandeep claim themselves to be major. They purport to have been in a relationship for over two years. They intended to marry each other but their decision was resisted by the parents of petitioner no.1 and her family members. However, the petitioners alleged to have solemnized marriage on 30.5.2020, contrary to the wishes of the private respondents at Shiv Durga Mandir, Village Ferozepur, Sector 19, Panchkula. Their grievance is that despite their persistent efforts to pacify or convince the private respondents they are not ready to accept their

relationship or reconcile with their marriage. Rather, the petitioners have been threatened with dire consequences and thus they apprehend danger to their lives as also their implication in some false case. Thus faced with this situation they had represented to respondent no.2 vide representation dated 30.5.2020 to take necessary measures to secure their lives and liberty. But to no avail.

In the wake of the above, and without commenting upon the veracity of the allegations set out in the petition as also the validity of the marriage of the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Hisar (respondent No.2), that, if any such representation, as indicated above, is pending, the same shall be considered forthwith and appropriate measures, as deemed necessary, shall be taken.

A copy of this order be sent to the Superintendent of Police, Hisar (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
