The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant habeas corpus has been filed by the petitioners for directing the officials respondents No.2 and 3 to get the detinue namely, Simran Kaur released from illegal detention of respondents no.4 and 5.

In response to the notices issued to the State, the status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jagadhari (Yamuna Nagar) has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 wherein it has been *inter alia* deposed as under:-

“7. That in view of investigation conducted so far by SI Parveen Kumar and statement got recorded by Rajbir Singh (father of Parminder Singh) and Simran Kaur (daughter of petitioner), it is clear that Simran Kaur has not been kidnapped or

abducted by respondent No.4 and 5 rather she had left her house with intention to marry with Parminder Singh and after solemnizing marriage, Parminder Singh and Simran Kaur are in Safe House at Ambala with the order of Additional Sessions Judge/Duty Judge, Ambala. It has also found during investigation, the petitioner has not been threatened by respondent No.4 and 5 as alleged in the petition. It is further humbly submitted that further legal action will be taken as per order passed by this Hon'ble Court. As such this Status report is submitted before this Hon'ble Court for kind perusal and the present petition has got no force or merits and the same deserves to be dismissed.”

In view of the above, no further orders are called for. The Habeas corpus stands disposed of.
