The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.186 dated 20.03.2020, under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the I.P.C. & Sections 61-1-14 of the Excise Act, registered at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

[2]. The petitioner was arrested on 20.03.2020. Thereafter, investigation against him has since been completed and challan submitted.

[3]. On the last date, Ld. State Counsel had sought time to verify, “whether there is any Firm by the name “Mahadev Enterprises”, from whom the petitioner had claimed to have obtained the goods for transportation by his truck”. But today, Ld. State Counsel submits that no information in this regard has come before him.

[4]. Be that as it may, in view of the fact that custody of the petitioner is not required any further for the purpose of investigation and he has remained in detention for more than five months by now, he is ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to the appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
