SUVIR SEHGAL J. (ORAL)

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.66, dated 11.10.2017 registered under Sections 8/15/18/29/60 of NDPS Act, at NCB Zonal Unit, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2 has placed on record communication dated 21.01.2020 wherein it has been submitted as under:-

"Gursewak Singh has joined the investigation and he couldn't be connected with the recovery at this stage. If any evidence comes against him in future investigation he would be issued summons u/s 67 of NDPS Act."

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case and the order dated 04.07.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in

Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

It is further observed that henceforth, in case, the petitioner is found indulging in any other case, the prosecution shall be at liberty to seek cancellation of his bail.
