The petition has been taken for hearing through video conference due to Covid-19 pandemic.

In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that he has applied for the registration of his car bearing No.PB-77-2222 and for the said purpose, he had already paid all the required fees in September, 2019 and complete road tax in October, 2019. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, a period of six months has elapsed since the payment of all the required fees and tax but, registration certificate of the car has not been issued to the petitioner by the authority concerned. Prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to pass an appropriate order for registration of his car forthwith.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief, which is being claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has sent a representation through an e.mail on 22.03.2020 (Annexure P/3) to respondent No.2, which is still pending consideration with respondent No.2 and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the same.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Monica Chhibber Sharma, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab. Learned State counsel submits that the respondent-State has no objection with regard to deciding of representation sent by the petitioner through e.mail dated 22.03.2020 (Annexure P/3) in a time bound manner.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent No.2 is directed to decide representation sent by the petitioner through e.mail dated 22.03.2020 (Annexure P/3), by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
