The petitioner prays for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.0104 dated 06.08.2019 registered under Sections 15, 18, 22, 25/61/85 of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (hereinafter to be referred as “the 1985 Act”) at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner was found in conscious possession of 110 Kg of poppy husk and 10 Kg of intoxicant powder. The petitioner was the only occupant of the car.

No doubt, the petitioner has been acquitted in four criminal cases, however, two more cases under the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, are still pending. The recovery from the petitioner is of commercial quantity.

Hence, no ground to grant regular bail to the petitioner is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
