On 05.06.2020, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 11 dated 29.01.2020 under Sections 379, 411 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, District Jagadhri.

Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to order dated 12.05.2020 passed in CRM-M-12178-2020 to contend that with respect to same allegation, the co-accused Sanjeev Kumar @ Sanju has already been granted anticipatory bail.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Deepak Sabherwal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State. He is not disputing the above said fact.

Keeping in view above, petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when called by the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, he will be released on bail

by the Investigating Officer on his furnishing bail bonds/sureties to his satisfaction, subject to the following conditions, as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.:-

- 1. that the petitioner will make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- 2. that the petitioner will not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;*
- 3. that the petitioner will not leave India without the prior permission of the Court;*
- 4. such other condition as may be imposed under sub section (3) of Section 437, as if the bail was granted under that section.*

List on 06.07.2020.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Ram Partap, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation, at this stage.

In view thereof, the order dated 05.06.2020 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
