The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.63 dated 28.07.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324 and 34 of Indian Penal Code (Section 326 IPC added subsequently) at Police Station Kotli Surat Mallian, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

On 11.06.2020, following order was passed:-

*“The petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.63 dated 28.07.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code (Section*

*326 of IPC added subsequently) at Police Station Kotli Surat Mallian, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.*

*As per case of the prosecution, the petitioner had attacked the first informant and given him four injuries while using Daatar, three on the left leg and one on the left wrist.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that initially the FIR was registered under Sections 323, 324 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code. The petitioner had joined the investigation and was released on bail by the Investigating Officer. He submits that the offence under Section 326 IPC has been added subsequently on 09.03.2020.*

*Notice of motion.*

*Mr. Surinder Pal Singh Tinna, Additional A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.*

*Adjourned to 16.07.2020.*

*In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide*

*by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2)  
Cr.P.C.”*

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Raghbir Singh states that in pursuance of aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required in further investigation of the case.

In view of above, order dated 11.06.2020 is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so by the Investigating Officer.
