The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 17.4.2020 (Annexure P/1) in which a direction was issued to the respondents, firstly to arrest the accused, secondly to look into the threat perception of the petitioner or her daughter, thirdly to send swabs to the chemical examination and fourthly to get the signatures of the prosecutrix on the forwarding letter/requisite forms etc. before doing the needful.

Status report and various affidavits have been filed before this Court stating therein that the main accused has since been arrested. Protection was granted to the petitioner. Swabs too have been sent for Chemical examination and the challan too has been filed in this case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the aforesaid facts.

In view of the same, no further orders are required to be passed in the present contempt petition. The same is dismissed as rendered infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondent(s) is discharged.
