The petitioner-Society has established a primary school in Sirsa in the year 2018. In the same year, recognition was also applied for but allegedly, no action has been taken upon the said application till date. Even a representation dated 24.1.2019 (Annexure P-11) has not been responded to.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that academic session 2020-2021 is about to start and that the school would suffer losses in case a decision on the application for recognition is delayed.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take appropriate action in accordance with law on the pending
