The learned State counsel has submitted that he has filed reply on the whatsapp group.

The Reader of this Court has shown the reply through whatsapp as per which the detenue Bhupinder Singh was detained under provisions of Sections 107 and 151 Cr.P.C. as there was apprehension of breach of peace near Hindu Sabha College, Amritsar. It is further mentioned in the reply that aforesaid Bhupinder Singh has since been released on bail on 9.6.2020.

Faced with the aforesaid position, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition

with liberty to avail of appropriate remedies in case he is able to establish that Bhupinder Singh had been illegally detained.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
