Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/ 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondent No.2 to grant 2nd chance for scrutiny of documents in view of the results of the petitioners.

At the outset, instead of pressing the petition on merits, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he would be satisfied in case the representation dated 06.03.2020 (P-10) which is pending for consideration with the Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula, is decided by the competent authority on some early date.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Learned State counsel is also not averse to the innocuous prayer made by the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction to the Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula to consider and decide the representation dated 06.03.2020 (P-10) filed by the petitioners, if the same is pending, in accordance with law expeditiously, but within three weeks from today.

Ordered accordingly.

Needless to say that if some adverse decision is taken against the petitioners, they would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.
