1. The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 20 dated 20.01.2019, registered under Sections 458 and 380 IPC read with Section 511 IPC. Police Station Sadar Rewari.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has not been named in the FIR. According to him, as per allegations in the FIR some unknown person attacked the complainant and tried to steal honey buckets. He submits that nothing was stolen. According to him, no test identification parade had been carried out and petitioner has been falsely implicated and is in custody since 13.02.2020.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel opposes the bail plea. According to him, the petitioner is a resident of Uttar Pradesh and if enlarged on bail, there is every apprehension of his evading the trial.

4. The petitioner is in custody since 13.02.2020. As per allegations in the FIR, the petitioner and his co-accused attempted to steal the honey buckets of complainant and in the process caused injuries. The investigation is over and commencement of trial is still awaited. In the current pandemic scenario, the trial of the case is not likely either to start or get over soon.

5. Taking wholesome view of the matter, the petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bond for an amount of Rs.25,000/- and one local surety of like amount to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate, Rewari, as the case may be.

6. Petition stands allowed accordingly.
