The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.445 dated 31.12.2019, under Sections 376, 506 and 34 IPC (later on Section 376 IPC was deleted and Sections 406, 420, 467, 468 and 471 were added) , registered at Police Station Kharkhoda, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations against the petitioners are that they are alleged to have taken money from the complainant for providing job to her son. The offence under Section 376 IPC was deleted in the course of investigation. He also contends that the FIR is counter blast to the FIR registered by the petitioners bearing FIR No.326 dated 27.11.2019 wherein the son of the complainant was alleged to have cheated the petitioners. The petitioners are in custody for over 3 ½ months and are not involved in any other criminal case.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Rakesh Kumar states that the challan has been filed on 31.07.2020.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners, especially when the petitioners are in custody for over 3 ½ months, they are not involved in any other criminal case, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
