The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.0004 (Annexure P-1) dated 03.01.2020, under Sections 307, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

[2]. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was arrested on 31.03.2020. He was not nominated in the original FIR and his name has subsequently been transpired during the investigation. Challan against him has already been submitted, after completion of the investigation.

[3]. It is further contended that the case of the petitioner stands exactly at par with co-accused, namely Sharanjit Singh @ Sharan, who was granted bail by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-12075-2020

on 11.05.2020.

[4]. Ld. State counsel does not dispute the above facts.

[5]. In view of the above and that petitioner stands on the same footing at par with co-accused Sharanjit Singh @ Sharan, the present petitioner, who has no history of any other crime associated with him, is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned, and rest of the directions which were passed in case of accused Sharanjit Singh @ Sharan shall also apply to him.
