GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of the restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Rohtash Singh, stated to be aged 50 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer to grant him anticipatory bail in case FIR No.259, dated 02.11.2019 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 201 of IPC and offence under Section 61-1-14 of Excise Act, registered at Police Station Badhra, District Charkhi Dadri.

Vide order dated 15.06.2020, the petitioner was granted interim bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Davinder Singh states that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial

interrogation is no more required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 15.06.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.
