The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.383 dated 22.12.2019, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Dabwali Sadar, District Sirsa.

2. The petitioner was arrested on 22.12.2019. 3500 tablets of *Tramadol Hydrochloride* were allegedly recovered from him. He was granted interim bail on 10.07.2020 by this Court, in view of the fact that the FSL Report regarding chemical analysis of the seized contraband was not available. But Ld. State counsel has sent a copy of the said Report today, according to which *Tramadol* was actually detected in the sample sent to the FSL, Madhuban.

3. Since recovery of the contraband from the petitioner was well above the commercial quantity, he is not entitled to the benefit of bail in this case, at this stage.

4. Consequently, the present petition stands dismissed and the interim bail earlier granted to the petitioner is hereby ordered to be cancelled.
