For the reasons mentioned in the application, the Applicants/

The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the
Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail in case FIR No.499, dated
27.10.2013, registered under Sections 395, 412 of the Indian Penal Code,
1860 at Police Station Manesar, District Gurugram.

2. It is claimed by Ld. Counsel for the Petitioner that his client
was never aware about the fact that he had been implicated in the present

case. He was declared a Proclaimed Offender *in absentia* and was ultimately arrested on 18th November, 2019. In the meantime, as many as seven other accused persons, who had also been Challaned in the same case were acquitted after completion of trial by the Court of Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram on 19th January, 2019 vide its Judgment (Annexure P-1).

3. On query of the Court, Ld. Counsel for the State submits that as per information provided to him, the Petitioner is not reported to be involved in any other criminal case.

4. In such circumstances, considering the long detention undergone by the Petitioner and the fact that several other Challaned accused persons, in the same case, had already been acquitted by the Competent Court after a regular trial, at this stage, the present Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
